Dear Jennifer Cashman,

Per our previous correspondence and your continued tacit agreement, we, Jason and Colleen Palmer, will continue to amend our "REAL ESTATE TAX BILL" to exclude "School Tax Amount" and "Education Tax Amount" for the two properties called 296 SHAKER ROAD. We, Jason, a man, and Colleen, a woman, will continue to voluntarily pay the other portions of the "REAL ESTATE TAX BILL", called "Municipal Tax Amount" and "County Tax Amount".

I have included text from previous letters as well as permanent links to previous letters for your review (page 2).

Notice to Agent is Notice to Principal; Notice to Principal is Notice to Agent:

I would like to give you, Jennifer Cashman, a woman, acting as TOWN CLERK – TAX COLLECTOR, NOTICE again (see letter Dec. 16, 2025) that your continuing to send "REAL ESTATE TAX BILLS" that do not reflect the amendments which you have agreed to (see page 2 and links to previous correspondence), we, the man Jason Palmer and the woman Colleen Palmer, consider these actions to be an act of willful harm inflicted on us; a trespass against us. Your actions, Jennifer Cashman, are threatening our religious freedom, our property and causing undue mental and emotional stress.

Moreover if thy brother shall trespass against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother.

Furthermore, I would like to NOTICE you, again, (see letter May, 22 2026) my fee schedule:

It is agreed that the **cost of performance**, such as but not limited to a performance in response to fraudulent letters and notices containing fraudulent or unsubstantiated claims similar to the letters and notices from Jennifer Cashman (JENNIFER CASHMAN) and the Town of Belmont (TOWN OF BELMONT), which are the subject of this letter, is **Five Hundred Thousand US dollars, which shall be due from agent, Jennifer Cashman and Five Hundred Thousand US dollars, which shall be due from principal, TOWN OF BELMONT to Colleen Palmer for performance.**

The contract regarding the "real estates" at 296 Shaker Road, often referred to as REAL ESTATE TAX BILL, is between the agents Jennifer Cashman and Colleen and Jason Palmer for the Legal Fictions TOWN OF BELMONT and COLLEEN & JASON PALMER. For any man, woman, legal person, corporation or other entity which would like to join our contract there will be a **Ten Million US dollars joinder fee**.

It continues to be our prayer that God's will be done in Earth as it is in Heaven. It is our hope that you, Jennifer Cashman, will cease harming us and will choose to honor your agreements.

Quoted from our May 9, 2025 letter:

Absent a rebuttal, and absent proof of the claim to our property as offered in the "REAL ESTATE TAX BILL", Jennifer Cashman, acting as Tax Collector and Town Clerk for the TOWN OF BELMONT in the STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE continues to acknowledge, understand and agree that the Contracts titled "REAL ESTATE TAX BILL" for our two properties known as 296 Shaker Rd. Belmont, New Hampshire, have been amended to exclude "Education Tax" and "School Tax" ad infinitum. Furthermore, any penalties in the form of "Tax Liens" and accompanying costs, "Tax Deeds", or any other claimed penalties such as "TAX DELINQUENCIES" and "UNREDEEMED TAX LIENS" are VOID nunc pro tunc.

Quoted from our May 13, 2024 letter and Affidavit:

We demand proof of the following:

- That the STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE, TOWN OF BELMONT, Jennifer Cashman acting as Town Clerk - Tax Collector, or any man or woman, principality, corporation, municipality, state, or government in Earth has the right to violate our unalienable right to religious freedom by imposing a tax that violates our sincerely-held beliefs.
